Timeline of Spain's history

5000bc	Iberian tribes inhabited the Iberian Peninsula
1000bc	Celts from Central Europe mixed with the Iberians
100	Christianity arrived in the area
400	Western Roman Empire collapsed
500	Western Visigoths established a kingdom
711	Berbers and Arabs spread Islam to the Iberian Peninsula from Northern Africa
1212	Fight of Tolosa, The Christian kingdoms took the Iberian Peninsula back from the Moslem caliphates, leaving only the Emirate of Granada in Southern Spain under Moslem rule
1230	Kingdoms of Leon ja Castile merged
1469	Kingdoms of Aragonia and Castile merged and as a result the modern Spain was born
1492	The last Moorish kingdom collapsed and the 800-year Moslem reign ended in the Iberian Peninsula
1492	Columbus sailed to Central and South America funded by Queen Isabella
1513	Navarra was attached to Spain
1581	The Netherlands split off from the Holy Roman Empire
1640	Portugal split off from the union with Spain after 60 years
1700	The Bourbon family rose in power after the Spanish Habsburg's family died away, Spain lost Belgium and parts of Italy to the Austrian Habsburgs, Sicily to the Savoia family and the British conquered Gibraltar
1807	Napoleon attacked Spain and made his brother Josef Bonaparte the King of Spain
1825	All Latin American territories had gained independence except Cuba and Puerto Rico
1898	Spain lost Cuba, Puerto Rico, Guam and the Philippines to USA
1939-75	General Francisco Franco's dictatorship
1977	First parliament elections in 40 years
1982	Spain joined NATO
1986	Spain joined the predecessor of EU
1992	Barcelona hosted the Summer Olympics
2008	Spain won the European Championship in football
2010	Spain won the FIFA World Cup in football
2017	Failed declaration of independence of Catalonia
2020	COVID-19 pandemic in Spain

Timeline of Spain's colonial history

1492	Christopher Columbus started the voyages to the Americas, Spain became the first superpower of the world
1494	Treaty of Tordesillas divided the newly discovered lands outside Europe between the Portuguese Empire and the Spanish Empire (Crown of Castile)
1492-1541	Spain colonized nearly the whole present-day Latin America
1520-1824	Spanish Viceroyalties ruled Latin America and parts of present-day USA
1778	Spain got Equatorial Guinea in an exchange of land from Portugal
1811-1828	Most of the Latin American countries became independent from Spain
1819-1830	Gran Colombia (Panama, Ecuador, Colombia, Venezuela)
1823-1840	Central American countries (Guatemala, Nicaragua, Honduras, El Salvador, Costa Rica) were unified as one state
1846-1848	Mexico lost California, Nevada, Utah and Arizona to USA
1898	Spanish-American War, Spain lost Puerto Rico, Cuba, Guam and the Philippines to USA
1903	Panama became independent from Colombia with the aid of USA
1968	Equatorial Guinea was the last colony to gain independence from Spain
