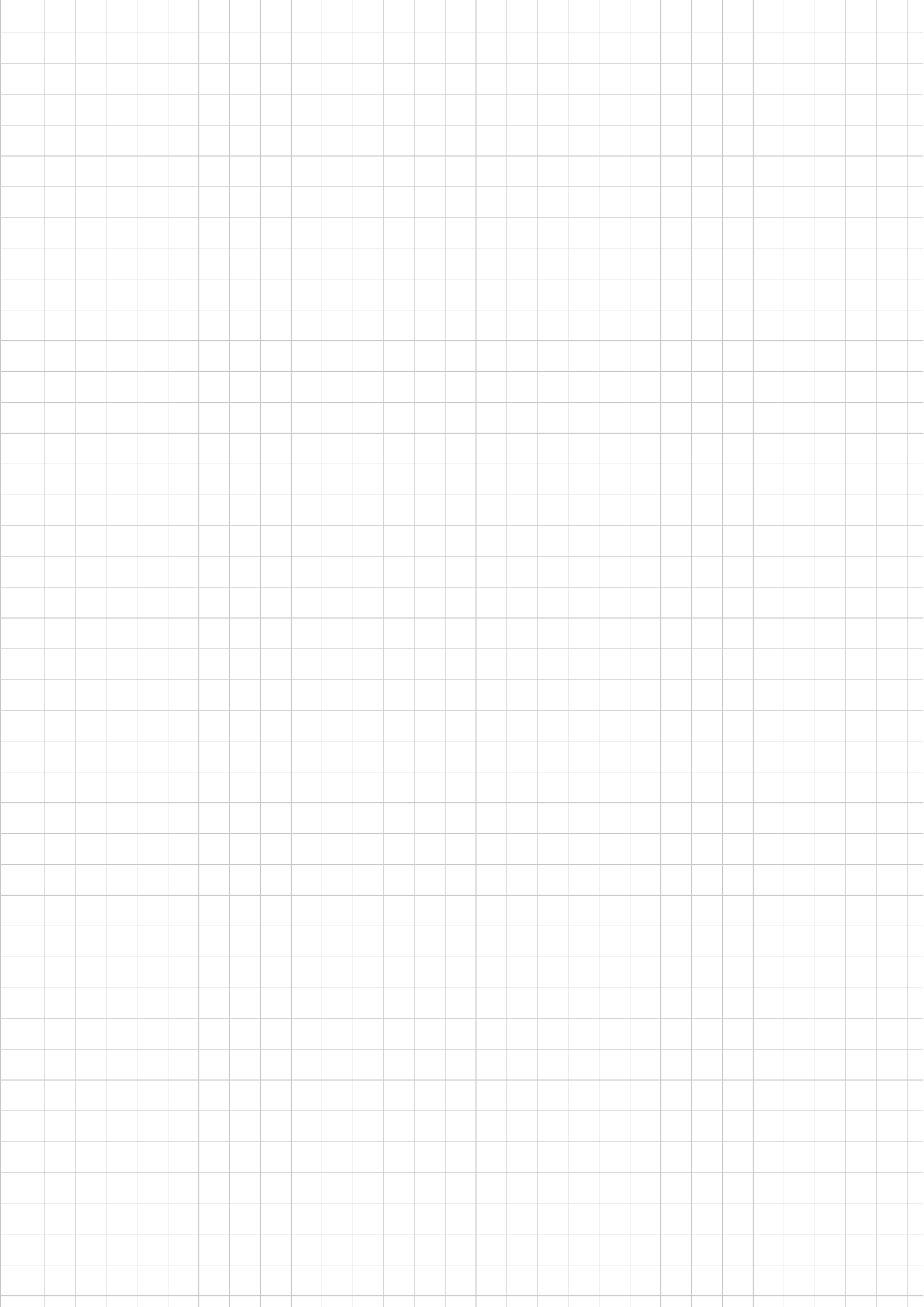

Ukrainian history timeline

Kievan Rus'

879	Prince Oleg united East Slavic lands into what became known as the Kievan Rus'
969	The Kievan Rus' ruler, Sviatoslav I of Kiev, destroyed the Khazar state
988	Vladimir the Great converted to Christianity and Christianized the Kievan Rus'
1019-1054	The Kievan Rus' reached its peak under Yaroslav the Wise
1132	The Kievan Rus' fragmented into separate principalities after the death of King Mstislav
1240	The Kievan Rus' power was ended by the Mongol invaders

Foreign rule

1253	Danylo Romanovich re-united all of south-western Rus becoming king of the Kingdom of Rus'
1349	Polish conquest of the Kingdom of Rus'
1441	The Crimean Khanate broke free from the Golden Horde and conquered most of modern southern Ukraine
1569	The Polish-Lithuanian Commonwealth was established, ruling parts of modern Ukraine

Cossack Hetmanate

1648-1657	Cossack uprising against Polish rule and the foundation of the Cossack Hetmanate
1657-1687	"The Ruin" was a 30-year chaotic period between Russia, Poland, Turks and Cossacks for control of Ukraine
1654	Treaty of Pereyaslavl began the process of transforming the Cossack Hetmanate into a Russian vassal state
1686	Treaty of Eternal Peace, Cossack Hetmanate regions were partitioned
1764	Russian Empire abolished the eastern Hetmanate, the remains of the Cossack Hetmanate

Russian Empire

1772-1795	Most of western Ukraine was absorbed into the Russian Empire through the partitions of Poland
1783	Russian Empire took over southern Ukraine through the annexation of the Crimean Khanate
1800s	Nationalism arose in Ukraine with the poet Taras Shevchenko as one of the key figures
1876	Russians banned Ukrainian literature and the center of the nationalist movement shifted from Kiev to Lviv
1900	Ukrainian Revolutionary Party was established in Kharkiv demanding a sovereign Ukraine
1917	Russian Revolution led to civil war in Russia
1918	Ukraine declared independence
1918-1919	Poland won the Polish-Ukrainian War and incorporated western Ukraine into Poland
1919	Unification Act between the Ukrainian People's Republic and West Ukrainian People's Republic aimed to create a unified Ukraine

Soviet Union

1920	Ukraine failed to gain independence and the Ukrainian SSR of the Soviet Union was established comprising most the territory of the Ukrainian People's Republic
1922	Ukraine became a founding member of the Soviet Union with Russia, Belarus and Transcaucasia
1932-1933	Great Famine "Holodomor" was a result of Soviet forced collectivization of agriculture
1939	Western Ukraine was annexed by the Soviet Union under the terms of the Nazi-Soviet Pact
1940	Bessarabia and Northern Bukovina were incorporated into the Ukrainian SSR
1941-1944	Ukraine suffered wartime devastation as Nazi Germany occupied the country
1945	After World War II there was resistance in western Ukraine against the Soviet Union
1954	Crimea was transferred to the Ukrainian SSR from the Russian SFSR in the 300th anniversary of the Treaty of Pereyaslavl
1986	Chernobyl Nuclear Power Plant accident happened near Pripyat in northern Ukraine

Independence

1991	Ukraine declared independence
1996	Ukraine adopted a new democratic constitution and introduced hryvnya as the national currency
2004	Viktor Yushchenko rose into power after the Orange Revolution
2010	Viktor Yanukovych won the presidential elections
2013	Maidan revolution against the government's decision to abandon plans to sign an association agreement with the European Union
2014	Crimea became part of Russia
2014	Petro Poroshenko became the president after protests requiring Yanukovych to resign
2017	Ukraine signed the association agreement with the European Union
2019	Actor Volodymyr Zelensky won the presidential elections

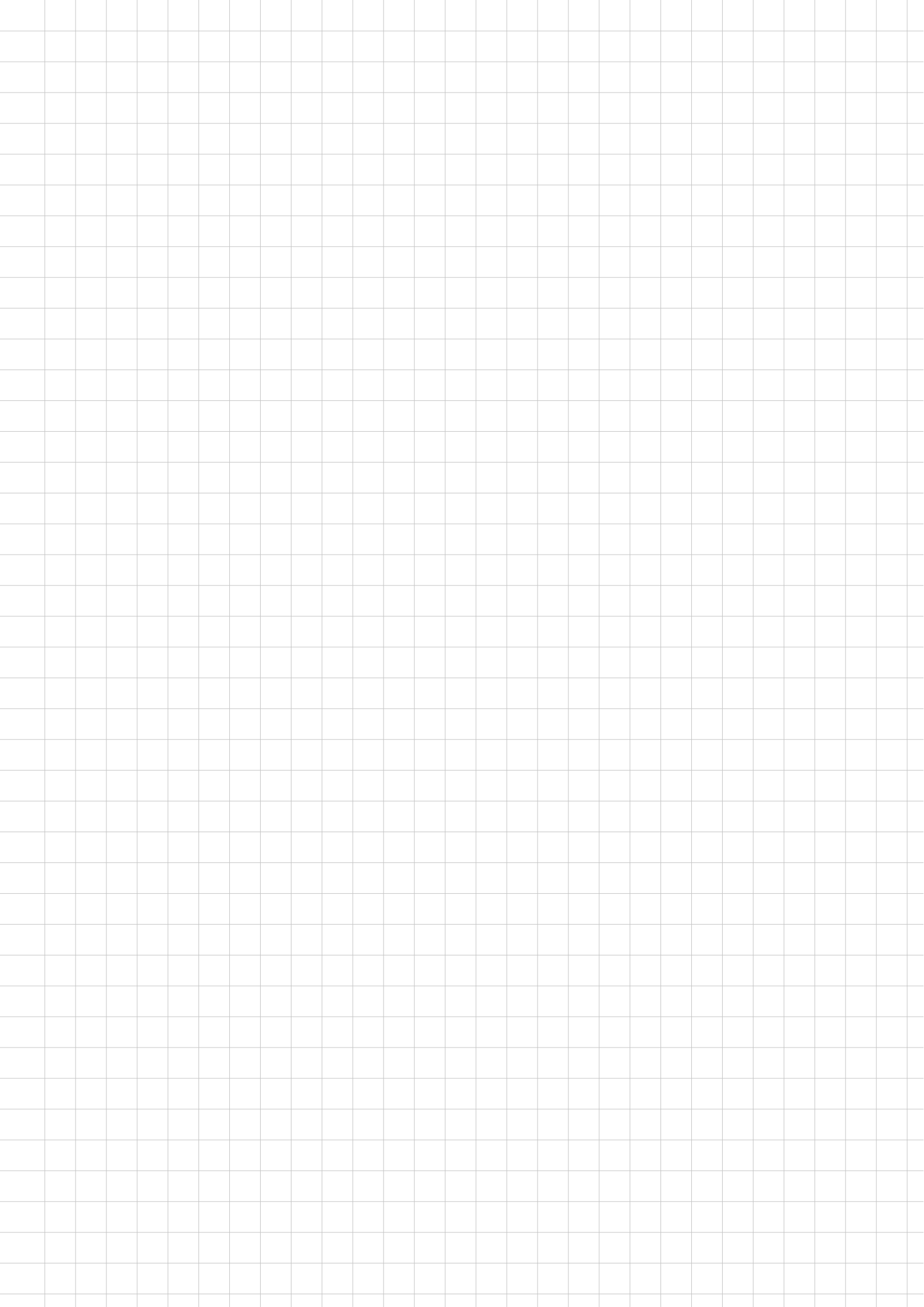
