Dear Reader

While collecting quotes for this book I was amazed at how many drivers there are in the F1 history. More than 800 drivers have participated in the F1 race weekends. We all remember the champions, but they would not exist without the other participants. This book gives the voice to the drivers who also deserve to be remembered, and not only the champions.

This book also involves a number of drivers that are left along the track. Drivers like Gilles Villeneuve, in the door of even greater success, or Jim Clark who was on the top of the world when he passed away. All the drivers are exposed to the same risks. Destiny is not necessarily only favorable to the champions.

After examining tens of thousands of quotes it is easy to see how the nature of the phrases has changed. During the early years of the sport, between 1950s and 1970s, approximately twenty drivers passed away each decade. In the beginning the sense of humor was extremely ironic before turning into a sarcasm while approaching the current decade. While this obviously involves a certain linkage to the driver. Alonso and Vettel are not so different as it might seem at first, but certainly different when comparing them the other drivers.

Many of these quotes symbolize the drivers. Kimi Räikkönen, Alain Prost, Bruce McLaren and Ayrton Senna provide us with brilliant quotes related to the sport. On the other hand, some of the not so well-known drivers, like Johnnie Parsons, Hernando da Silva Ramos and Brian Redman, have been able to crystallize their thoughts amazingly well. Many of the drivers' quotes have become classics. That is why the book has collected only the quotes that characterize the drivers.

There are differences in attitude between the drivers. Paul Frere reminiscent of the old Olympic spirit: "I didn't wish to be World Champion, I just wanted to take part". Michael Schumacher on the other hand tend to tell the hard and unyielding nature: "We are always there, we always fight, we never give up... that's why we are here."

May this book open the mindset of the drivers, and respect the similarities and the differences of the drivers' ways of thinking.
